Description of the scholarship:

Participating students will complete an online course (consisting of 8 hours) which will focus on performance themes including Personal Drive, Learning Mindset, Confidence,

and many more. Once finishing each module, students will have the opportunity to consolidate their learning and complete an online quiz.

The 4 students with the highest scores across all modules, and from all participating universities, will consequently win a Santander Development grant of £10,000 each - this should support the respective recipients with their professional and/or personal development (for example, funding their tuition fees, paying for travel costs to interviews, supporting their start-ups, etc.).

Students will be able to complete the course from Monday 11th January 2021 until Friday 19th February 2021. Please note: the online material will be accessible to students until mid-March 2021 in case they want to review or revisit any of the information. However, students must complete all of the online tests before the 19th February in order to be able to win one of the four prizes.

The 4 winners will be informed on **Wednesday 24th February 2021** via an email from the Director of Santander Universities UK. Similarly, all students who complete the 8-hour content and quizzes will receive a digital certificate via email by the end of March.
